Why do we covenant with God and the members of His body?
We become who and what we are by committing to be and do!

1. The Membership Covenant is a commitment we make to Jesus Christ and also to the Christ the King Anglican Church Family.

"Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household."
-Ephesians 2:19 (NIV)

I will support the MEMBERSHIP of my church...

- ... by seeing myself as God's child
- ... by uniting and committing myself to God and my church family
- ... by cooperating with those who lead

2. The Maturity Covenant is a commitment to form the habits necessary for spiritual growth.

"But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." 2 Peter 3:18 (NIV)

"Have nothing to do with godless myths and old wives' tales; rather train yourself to be godly." 1Tim. 4:7 (NIV)

"Take the time and trouble to keep yourself spiritually fit." 1Timothy 4:7 (Ph)

I will support the MATURITY of my church...

- ... by worshipping regularly
- ... by praying and reading my Bible regularly
- ... by building up the Body of Christ through fellowship
- ... by giving a tithe of my finances (or work toward a tithe) regularly out of gratitude

3. The Ministry Covenant is a commitment to discovering and using my God-given gifts and abilities in serving God and others.

"Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms." 1Peter 4:10 (NIV)

"There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord....Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it." 1Corinthians 12:5, 27

I will share the MINISTRY of my church...

- ... by discovering my God-given gifts, passion and personal style
- ... by exercising those gifts in the world for God's purpose
- ... by cultivating a heart for service

4. The Missions Covenant is a commitment to share the Good News with others by word and deed.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8 (NIV)

"Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect." 1Peter 3:15 (NIV)

I will support the MISSION of my church...

- ... by inviting the unchurched and warmly welcoming them
- ... by praying for a fuller expression of the fruit of the Spirit
- ... by living a godly life and acting in love toward others
- ... by being the salt and light that God desires me to be
- ... by giving to missions
